

League of the Prophets Curriculum

Course Overview

The *League of the Prophets* curriculum is designed to equip students with a comprehensive understanding of the prophetic ministry through three structured parts: **Prophetic Foundations, Dimensions of the Prophetic, and Prophetic Activations and Practical Training.** Each lesson focuses on historical, biblical, and practical elements, helping students understand and grow in their unique prophetic gifts and callings.

Part 1: Prophetic Foundations

1. Navi or Nabi Prophets: The Spokesman Prophets

Lesson Overview:

This lesson introduces the *Navi or Nabi Prophets*, who are inspired spokesmen and mouthpieces of God. Students will learn the historicity and role of Navi or Nabi prophets, how they ministered under divine inspiration, and their function as oracles of God. This class will focus on teaching students about divine communication, how to hear the voice of the Holy Spirit, and how to minister the oracles of God with accuracy and clarity.

2. Ra'ah Prophets: The Seers

Lesson Overview:

This lesson focuses on Ra'ah Prophets, the seers who provide guidance, direction, and navigation through prophetic revelation. Students will study the history and emergence of seers, with an emphasis on the Samuel-type prophetic anointing. They will learn how to reveal the secrets of God's heart and use prophetic knowledge to minister direction and wisdom. This lesson also teaches students how to prophetically locate through words of knowledge while ministering with the heart of God.

3. Chozeh Prophets: The Visionary Prophets

Lesson Overview:

This lesson covers Chozeh Prophets, who operate as beholders of divine visions, including angelic activity, open-eye visions, and trances. Students will learn about the prophetic frequency of seeing in the Spirit and how to gaze into spiritual realms. The course will teach them how to interpret and communicate visions and understand the importance of beholding the word of the Lord.

4. The Dreamers: Night Visionaries

Lesson Overview:

This lesson focuses on the prophetic role of night visionaries, inspired by the Josephtype anointing. Students will learn how to interpret dreams, decode night visions, and communicate God's intent through parabolic language. The course will teach practical skills for understanding dreams and translating their meanings into prophetic messages that align with Scripture.

Part 2: Dimensions of the Prophetic

1. The Spirit of Prophecy

Lesson Overview:

Students will learn about the Spirit of Prophecy, the anointing that enables individuals to prophesy under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. This course will teach how the Spirit of Prophecy operates within congregational settings and the importance of creating environments conducive to prophetic flow.

2. The Gift of Prophecy and the Gifts of the Spirit

Lesson Overview:

This course explains the Gift of Prophecy as one of the gifts of the Holy Spirit and explores its biblical foundation and practical application. Students will also study the other gifts of the Spirit (e.g., words of knowledge, healing, discernment) and how they correlate with prophetic ministry. The class will teach students how to identify and utilize these gifts effectively.

3. The Prophetic Anointing

Lesson Overview:

This lesson focuses on the Prophetic Anointing, the divine empowerment to minister prophetically. Students will learn how to cultivate and sustain the anointing, recognize its manifestations, and operate in their unique prophetic calling with boldness and accuracy.

4. The Prophetic Mantle

Lesson Overview:

The Prophetic Mantle course provides a historical backdrop of the mantle worn by prophets as a symbol of authority and responsibility. Students will learn about the transfer of prophetic mantles, their spiritual significance, and how to carry the mantle with humility and integrity.

5. The Prophetic Presbytery

Lesson Overview:

This course focuses on prophetic ministry through the laying on of hands and impartation. Students will learn how to prophesy in leadership contexts, affirm ministry gifts, and set individuals into God-ordained offices through ordination. The course also

teaches the importance of collaboration with pastoral and apostolic leadership in prophetic presbytery.

6. The Prophecy of Scripture

Lesson Overview:

This lesson emphasizes that the most sure word of prophecy is the Word of God. Students will learn how to prophesy in alignment with Scripture, ensuring that all prophetic utterances are biblically grounded. This course will teach students how to use Scripture as a foundation for inspired prophetic declarations.

Part 3: Prophetic Activations and Practical Training

1. Prophetic Exercises and Activations

Lesson Overview:

This course provides direct and firsthand opportunities for students to practice prophesying, ministering, and hearing God's voice. Students will learn prophetic protocol, how to communicate the word of the Lord effectively, and how to operate in their unique prophetic frequency (prophet, seer, or dreamer).

2. Prophetic Demonstrations

Lesson Overview:

Students will learn how to demonstrate the Word of the Lord through teaching, preaching, and various prophetic expressions. This course emphasizes putting prophetic words into action, such as ministering healing when teaching or preaching on healing.

3. Prophetic Character vs. Gifting

Lesson Overview:

This lesson highlights the importance of character over gifting in prophetic ministry. Students will learn how to prophesy with integrity, wisdom, and understanding, while ensuring their lives align with biblical principles of holiness and humility.

4. The Gifts of the Spirit

Lesson Overview:

This course explores the Gifts of the Spirit in-depth, with a focus on their application in prophetic ministry. Students will learn how to operate in each gift (i.e., discernment, healing, prophecy) and integrate them into prophetic activations and demonstrations.

Prophetic Cohorts

Students will be divided into three prophetic cohorts based on their primary gifting:

1. The Prophets (Spokespersons):

 These students are trained to speak the word of the Lord as mouthpieces and oracles of God.

2. The Seers: (Visionaries or Beholders of Visions)

• This cohort includes Ra'ah Prophets, Chozeh Prophets, and watchmen, focusing on visual and revelatory prophetic insight.

3. The Dreamers (Night Visionaries):

• These students are trained to interpret and minister through dreams and visions, focusing on parabolic language and spiritual perceptivity.

This curriculum provides a thorough foundation for prophetic ministry, equipping students with the biblical, historical, and practical skills necessary to grow and thrive in their unique callings.
